

Cuba: Anayansi Rodriguez Assumes as New Deputy FM

Diplomat Anayansi Rodriguez has taken over the post of Deputy Minister at the Foreign Affairs Ministry of Cuba, after holding several responsibilities in defense of the island"s foreign policy.

Rodriguez was the Cuban permanent representative before the UN, after she held a post in Geneva as Cuban representative with the United Nations and other international organizations in that Swiss city and her work in the Foreign Ministry at the head of the Multilateral Affairs Office.
