In an article entitled Washington International Congress, its history, its elements and trends, published in La Nacion, Argentina, on December 19, 1889, Marti warned: 'Spanish America was saved from the tyranny of Spain; and now, after seeing with judicial eyes the antecedents, causes and factors of the invitation, it is urgent to say, because it is the truth, that the time has come for Spanish America to declare its second independence'.

Cuba is remembering its national hero today with several activities, among them the traditional March of the Torches in Havana, to which the president, Miguel Díaz-Canel, confirmed his attendance.
