El informe divulgado por la IAAF precisa que previo al encuentro se realizaron miles de pruebas aleatorias y anuncia un programa de inteligencia dirigido a que las muestras congeladas y almacenadas estén disponibles para futuros re-análisis cuando los avances de la ciencia lo permitan.

Esto se confirma como respuestas a lo sucedido casi en la antesala de la cita universal cuando The Sunday Times dio a conocer que un reportaje que llamó "Revelado: secreto más sucio del deporte", y en el que denunciaba supuesto mal manejo de más de 12 mil pruebas practicadas a unos cinco mil atletas entre el 2001 y el 2012.
