
United States: New Sign of Chaos?

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In the midst of the complex situation in the United States, new elements are added that will make it more complicated.

Europa News agency reported last Sunday that as a result of a poll, 8 out of 10 voters say "it's a state out of control."

The investigation covered the pandemic, the economic crisis and Trump's inability to unify the country. And it was published, this week, by NBC and The Wall Street Journal.

Another fact to keep in mind is that 80% of registered voters in both parties believe that "things are normally out of control in the United States."

Meanwhile, 15% believe that "the situation is on track."

As for the impact of the coronavirus, 63%, counting both parties, "are very worried or somewhat worried about getting the Covid-19"

In turn, 46% describe the state of the economy as 'bad' and 5% think that the country's economic health is "excellent".

It's the highest percentage of negativity recorded in this survey since 2012.

Voting intent investigations place Trump seven points below former Vice President Joe Biden.

Hence, the general trend not favorable to Trump that has prevailed in recent weeks is reinforced.

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
