
Kucinich: Bush And Cheney Should 'Absolutely' Be In Jail

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He states, "The war in Iraq, the people who started it based on lies, why are they not in jail?" He disputes the notion that Barack Obama is an anti-war president, saying that myth was created by the *New York Times*. We cannot afford that, whoever had that idea, it was not a good idea.

In this world, the more power someone has the less likely they are to be able to be accountable to justice...President Obama doesn't tell the truth about how we got into Iraq, that it was based on a lie.
