
Cuban Ambassador Arranges Reception

Jesus De Los Angeles Aise Sotolongo, Cuban ambassador to the DPRK, hosted a reception at the general-service ship Mujigae on Monday on the occasion of the 60th anniversary of the victory of Cuban revolution.
