

Michelle Bachelet: Naïve or Ignorant?

Michelle Bachelet, United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights, made a huge mistake last Thursday.

She took the side of those who attempted a *coup d'État* last April 30 against the legitimate government of Venezuela.

In this regard, Jorge Arreaza, Venezuela's FM stated:
