
Brazil Wins Chile 1-0, Mexico Beats Ecuador by Minimum Score

Roberto Firmino scored the only goal in the friendly match this Sunday between Brazil and Chile at the Arsenal Stadium in England. This was Brazil's eight consecutive victory since its disappointing performance in the World Cup it hosted last year.

Firmino entered the playing field with 29 minutes left, and 12 minutes later he scored defeating Chilean goalie Claudio Bravo.

Barcelona striker Neymar Junior and Chilean player Alexis Sanchez were the most valuable players of a game marred by fouls.

Brazil entered the field on Sunday after defeating France 3-1 last week. The Brazilian national team has won Chile 63 out of 70 games, according to statistics.
