The film exhibition was made up by fiction, documentary and animation films dealing with elements in Latin American and Native American culture. The exhibitions are focused in demystifying the stereotypes of these ethnic minorities that are still present in the US community.

Recently, the documentary won the Marcel Sisniega Award at the 3<sup>rd</sup> World Festival of Extreme Cinema, in San Sebastian de Veracruz, Mexico. In 2013, it won the Vigia Award, granted by the sub venue in Matanzas province during the 35th New Latin American International Film Festival.
