

Cuba works hard to produce its own seeds

Big transnational corporations manipulate markets and condition prices of seeds, therefore Cuba needs to produce and preserve its own domestically.

PhD Sergio Rodríguez Morales, member of the Cuban Council of State, made that statement during the International Meeting on Urban, Sub-urban and Family Agriculture underway in Havana.

Producing and preserving our own seeds is vital for the development of Cuban agriculture, he said.
