
Ricky Martin Gives Free Show in Buenos Aires with Symphony Orchestra

The artists, who come from different musical genres ranging from rock to cumbia, on Saturday split into pairs to sing symphonic versions of numbers from their own repertoires.

For the first time, the Puerto Rican singer performed three of his best-known songs – “Fuego de noche, nieve de día,” “Tu recuerdo” and “Disparo al corazón” – in a symphonic format before a live audience, despite the rainy conditions in the Argentine capital.

Argentines Lali Esposito, David Lebon and Elena Roger, along with more than 20 others, were among the performers to take the stage with the Buenos Aires Symphony Orchestra and the Argentine Polyphonic Chorus.

The artists also joined together as a group to perform the South American country's national hymn.
