

Maduro Praises Work of Fidel Castro in Defense of Mankind

Venezuelan President Nicolas Maduro praised the work of the historical leader of the Cuban Revolution, Fidel Castro, in defense of the just causes of the mankind, reported today the website of the Ministry of Communication and Information.
