

Enrique Iglesias' 'Bailando' Becomes First Spanish Song to Surpass Billion Views on YouTube

People can't seem to stop dancing to the beat of <u>Enrique Iglesias</u>' "Bailando." The urban-flamenco party anthem, released in 2014 and featuring <u>Descemer Bueno</u> and <u>Gente de Zona</u>, has reached a new milestone, hitting one billion views on YouTube. That in itself is an achievement, but the fact that it's the first Spanish-language song to reach those numbers is even more impressive.

"Thank you guys so much for getting Bailando Spanish version to 1 BILLION views. Incredible!!!," said the Spanish heartthrob on Instagram.

Iglesias is currently on his Sex & Love tour, which, to date, has attracted over one million people around the world and counting. Up next he's <u>nominated for two Premios Tu Mundo</u>, in the favorite pop artist category and "party-starting song" for "El Perdón," his other mega-hit with <u>Nicky Jam</u>. A <u>new bilingual version</u> of the song, titled "Forgiveness," aims to get it a comparable amount of play as its Spanish-language counterpart.

Iglesias will probably have more to toast to in the future. His longtime manager Fernando Giaccardi, who made it onto the <u>2015 Billboard Latin Power Players List</u>, recently said of his superstar client, "With Enrique, it's never enough. It's like, 'Great, we did this. Now what?' "
