
President of Costa Rica Travels to Cuba with Broad Trade Agenda

More than 50 businessmen will accompany the President of Costa Rica, Luis Guillermo Solís, on his first official visit to Cuba on Sunday, reported an official statement. The text said that this visit to the island is focused on promoting trade, while completes the process of normalization of diplomatic relations dynamic agenda, which were restored in 2009.

The coming Monday Solís will participate in a business meeting organized by the Foreign Trade Corporation of Costa Rica (PROCOMER) and the Centre for the Promotion of Foreign Trade and Foreign Investment of Cuba.
