
Latin Soccer Stars to Be Protagonists in Champions League

PSG will match Manchester City at the Parc des Princes in Paris, with a leader such as Swedish Zlatan Ibrahimovic, who will also have the support of players like Angel di Maria (Argentina), Edilson "The Cannibal" Cavani (Uruguay) and Brazilians Lucas Moura, David Luiz and Thiago Silva, among others.

The Manchester City, coached by Chilean Manuel Pellegrini, counts on Sergio "Kun" Aguero (Argentina), Willy Caballero (Argentina), and Brazilians Fernando and Fernandinho.

Both clubs are classifying for the eighths finals, trying to reach the semifinals for the first time in their respective history, but PSG has been moving to try to reach the semifinals in another four times before.
