

Cuban Firm Awarded Prize by ITU in Geneva

The firm of Informatics Solutions Softel was awarded today the prize of the International Telecommunications Union (ITU) in the category of electronic health for the project of informatization of the Cuban health system.

The award was given in the context of the World Forum on the Information Society (WFIS), running in this Swiss city through May 6, according to a communique issued by Cuba's Permanent Mission in Geneva.
