
Raul Meets with Visiting PM of St. Kitts and Nevis

The President of the councils of State and Ministers, Army General Raul Castro, met on Tuesday afternoon with Doctor Denzil LLeuwellyn Douglas, Prime Minister and Minister of Finances, Sustainable Development, Development of Human Resources, Social Empowerment and Social Security of the Federation of Saint Kitts and Nevis, who is on an official visit to Cuba.
