
Russian Foreign Minister Stresses Fidel Castro's Universal Relevance

Moscow, Nov 29 (Prensa Latina) Fidel Castro made a great contribution to guarantee morale in the international arena, something we now lack, declared Foreign Minister Serguei Lavrov when paying tribute here to the historic leader of the Cuban Revolution.

In several occasions, I had the privilege to talk with him when he was still actively working in 2004 and then in other visits, when he was already out of his position, I visited his house and for me those conversations remain as if it had taken place yesterday, he emphasized.

On September 13, Lavrov headed a ceremony at the Foreign Ministry, where he launched the Russian version of the book Fidel Castro: the time guerrilla fighter, an opportunity that he used to highlight the universal qualities of the

Cuban leader.

During the event it was also celebrated the 90th birthday of the Commander, as the Russian people refer to the Cuban leader.
